## **Opportunity:**

If you are a speciality trainee, nurse, radiographer or allied health professional, you have the opportunity to submit a case study for BSIR IOUK 2025.

## **Eligibility:**

To submit a case study for BSIR IOUK 2024, you **must** be either a speciality trainee, medical student, nurse, radiographer or allied health professional. Submissions made by consultants will be automatically disqualified. Multiple submissions can be made, however only one submission will be awarded a prize.

If accepted, you will be expected to attend in person.

#### **Brief:**

Case study title: "The Interventional Oncology case I learned most from".

Entrants are asked to provide a case study report based on their own experience of a specific case on Interventional Oncology. The report should provide a description of the case, with reflection, including the key learning points with relevant images (3 max). As the aim of the case study is to provide personal reflection. It is expected that the entrant will be the sole author. Any submission that does not fulfil the 'brief', will be rejected. Word count: 500 max.

#### **Scoring:**

Case study's will be scored on the below:

- 1. Construction of case study
- 2. Case study content
- 3. Relevance to the case study title
- 4. Quality of reflection
- 5. Quality of images used.

Please identify whether patient consent and institutional review board approval were granted. If no statement is made, it will be assumed that this has not been sought or given. Off-label use of any devices must be declared.
